and third countries not associated to the Programme

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. This agreement is valid for the Erasmus+ call years **2022/2023 - 2028/2029** in: **KA131 Mobility of higher education students and staff programme**. The institutions commit to sound and transparent management of funds allocated to them through Erasmus+ and to respect the quality requirements of the Programme, outlined in the [Erasmus Charter for Higher Education](#) and in this agreement. The institutions agree on exchanging their mobility-related data according to the [principles of GDPR](#) and in line with the technical standards of the [European Student Card Initiative](#), when this becomes available for international mobility involving third countries not associated to the Programme.

Sending institutions located in EU/EEA countries have to ensure compliance with the provisions of art. 46 GDPR for all participants' personal data exchanged in the context of their mobility with institutions from non-EU/EEA countries without an adequacy decision, on the condition that enforceable data subject rights and effective legal remedies for data subjects are available in the respective third country. The participants should be informed in a transparent manner about the level of protection of their personal data, if this is different from the one where the sending institution is located.

4. Partnership arrangements: fees and organisational support funds

In accordance with the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education, partners commit to charge no additional fees to students:

- in connection with the organisation or administration of their Erasmus+ mobility period. Any violation to this rule by the partners shall be brought to the attention of the National Agency and may lead to the termination of the participation in the project linked to this inter-institutional agreement, if no corrective measures are taken.
- for tuition, registration, examinations or access to laboratory and library facilities. Nevertheless, they may be charged small fees on the same basis as local students for costs such as insurance, student unions and the use of miscellaneous material.

5. Outreach and Selection of participants: calendar, application procedure and requirements

- Partners commit to do outreach to participants with fewer opportunities to encourage their participation in the Programme and, where needed, agree on a common strategy to meet indicative inclusion targets.
- Partners commit to run selection procedures for mobility activities that are fair, transparent and documented, ensuring equal opportunities for participants eligible for mobility. The calls for applications must be public and an appeal procedure must be in place. Under no circumstances shall applicants and selected participants incur any costs during application and selection procedures.
- In the case of student mobility, partners will ensure that other elements beyond academic merit are also taken into account to ensure participation of students with fewer opportunities. Selection criteria and procedures must be clearly communicated in the call for applications.

6. Preparation and support

The Higher Education Institution(s) in an EU Member State or associated third country commit(s) to:

All involved Higher Education Institutions (HEI) commit to the following preparation and support measures.



Information and assistance can be provided by the contact points and information sources in the table below:

- The receiving institution will guide incoming mobile participants in finding **accommodation**, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education. It is considered best practice to use the individual grant to pay for the deposit of dormitories.
- The sending institution ensures that outgoing mobile participants are well prepared for their activities abroad by undertaking activities to achieve the necessary level of **linguistic proficiency** and develop students' **intercultural competences**.
- The receiving institution provides assistance related to obtaining **insurance**, when required, for incoming and outgoing mobile participants, according to the requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education and use project funds in the most inclusive way to cover related costs partially or in full. The receiving institution will inform mobile participants of cases in which insurance coverage is not automatically provided.
- The receiving institution will inform about the existence of relevant infrastructure and provide support to incoming **participants with fewer opportunities**.
- The receiving institution provides **appropriate mentoring and support arrangements** for mobile participants, as well as **integrate incoming mobile participants** into the wider student community and in the Institution's everyday life.
- The institutions commit to encourage participants to act as **ambassadors of the Erasmus+ Programme** during their mobility and share their mobility experience, e.g. by providing information about the existence of Erasmus+ alumni networks, inviting former participants in promotion activities, etc.

7. Recognition

Institutions commit to:

- Ensure that student and staff mobility for education or training purposes is based on a learning agreement for students and a mobility agreement for staff validated in advance between the sending and receiving institutions or non-academic organisations and the mobile participants.
- Accept all activities indicated in the learning agreement, or according to the learning outcomes of the modules completed abroad, as automatically counting towards the degree, provided these modules have been satisfactorily completed by the mobile student.
- Partners commit to take measures to ensure the recognition of student and staff mobility upon return to the sending institution, including:
 - Providing incoming mobile students and their sending institutions with transcripts free-of-charge. The documents must be in English or in the language of the sending institution and containing a full, accurate and timely record of the achievements at the end of the mobility period.
 - A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5-10 days after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
 - Providing students on traineeships and staff with a certificate for the activities completed. It is recommended to issue a certificate towards the end of the mobility period.

8. Grading systems of the institutions

It is recommended that receiving institutions provide the statistical distribution of grades or make the information available through [EGRACONS](#) according to the descriptions in the [ECTS users' guide](#). The table will facilitate the interpretation of each grade awarded to students and will facilitate the credit transfer by the sending institution.

9. Termination of the agreement


This Agreement will take effect immediately once signed by both parties and will remain in force for academic years 2022/2023 to 2028/2029 based on the Erasmus+ Programme from the date of signing. This Agreement will be subject to revision or modification by mutual consent given in writing. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given.

In the event a Party materially breaches its obligations according to this Agreement, the other Party may terminate the Agreement. However, the Agreement may only be terminated if the breaching Party has not remedied such breach within thirty (30) days after receipt of a written demand.

In case this Agreement has also been translated into a language other than English, all of the copies will be equally binding but in the event of any discrepancies in the text arising from translation, the English text/agreement shall prevail.

The Parties agree to solve in a friendly manner any controversy arising from the interpretation of the present Agreement. The competent court determined in accordance with the applicable national law shall have sole jurisdiction to hear any dispute between the organisation and the participant concerning the interpretation, application or validity of this Agreement, if such dispute cannot be settled amicably. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
